Woodland Compost Site 4191 Woodland Drive, Two Rivers, WI

- April 1st through October 31st
Monday-Friday 10 am – 6 pm **Saturday** 8 am – 4 pm
- November 1st through November 15th
Monday-Friday 8 am – 4 pm **Saturday** 8 am – 4 pm
- November 16th through March 31st Woodland Compost Site is **Closed**

Accepted Items

Grass, leaves, flowers, plants, pumpkins, fruit, vegetables, garden waste, yard waste, brush, branches smaller than 6 inches in diameter and less than 5 feet long, woodchips, saw dust, and Holiday trees.

Unacceptable Items

Large branches **greater than 6 inches in diameter or longer than 5 feet**, stumps, animal waste, sod with soil on, topsoil, dirt, rocks, gravel, plastic, garbage bags, treated or untreated lumber, construction and demolition waste, TVs, electronics, and trash.

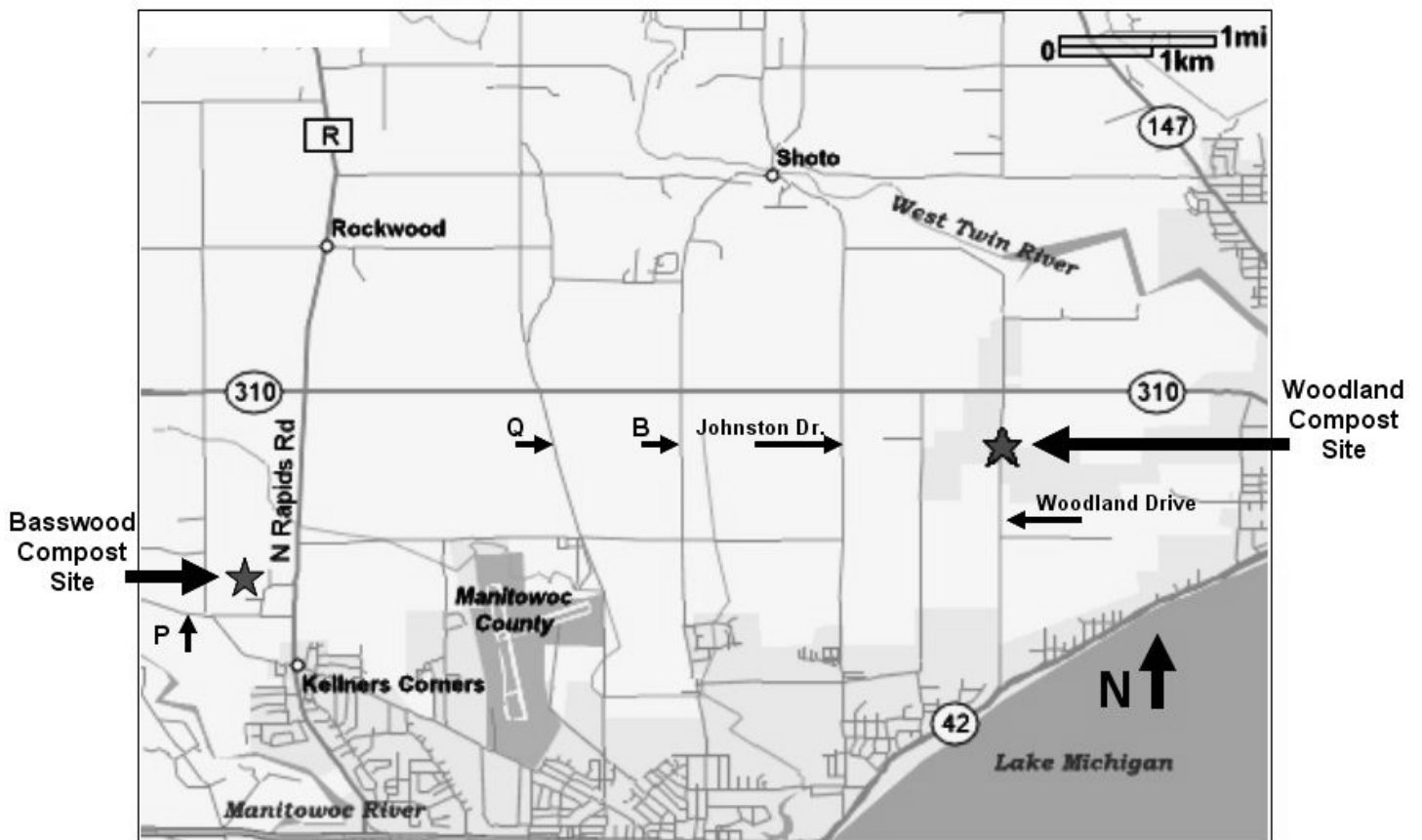

Benefits of Compost

- Reduces the need for water, fertilizers, and pesticides
- Enriches soils
- Helps clean contaminated soil
- Helps prevent pollution
- Reduces weed growth

Benefits of Woodchips

- Helps retain soil moisture
- Prevents heavy rain damage
- Increases survival of new trees
- Reduces soil temperature extremes
- Prevents direct contact of vegetables with soil
- Reduces weed growth
