April 1st through November 15th
Monday-Friday 10 am – 6 pm **Saturday** 8 am – 6 pm

Accepted Items

Grass, leaves, flowers, plants, pumpkins, fruit, vegetables, garden waste, yard waste, brush, branches smaller than 6 inches in diameter and less than 5 feet long, clean woodchips, clean sawdust, and natural holiday trees.

Unacceptable Items

Branches greater than 6 inches in diameter or longer than 5 feet, stumps, animal waste, sod with soil on, topsoil, dirt, rocks, gravel, plastic, garbage bags, treated or untreated lumber, construction and demolition waste, electronics, ashes, trash, planting pots and landscape fabric.

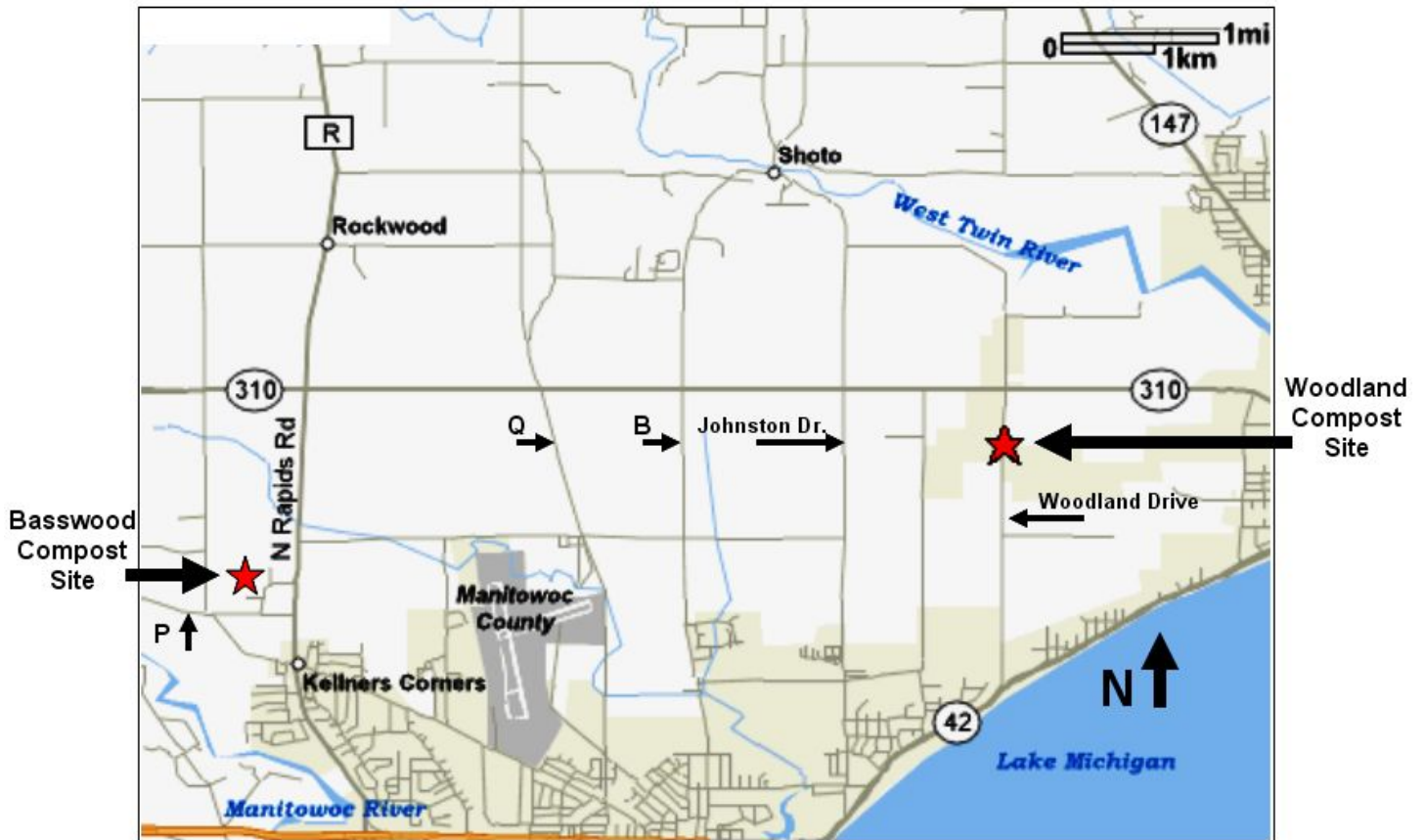

Delivery costs \$30.50 per load. Delivery service is generally available March through November and can be made by calling the Recycling Center during business hours. Loading is generally available M-F between 7:30am and 3:30pm at the Basswood site only. Loading is not available on Saturdays. Please call ahead for large orders over 10 cubic yards or for specific questions. The Main Office and Compost Sites are closed on Sundays and Holidays.

These areas are under 24 hour surveillance. Illegal dumping is subject to fine per Manitowoc Code Section 6.17. Placing unaccepted items in an otherwise designated recycling container or pile is considered illegal dumping and is subject to fine.

Benefits of Compost

- Reduces the need for water, fertilizers, and pesticides
- Enriches soils
- Helps clean contaminated soil
- Helps prevent pollution
- Reduces weed growth

Benefits of Woodchips

- Helps retain soil moisture
- Prevents heavy rain damage
- Increases survival of new trees
- Reduces soil temperature extremes
- Prevents direct contact of vegetables with soil
- Reduces weed growth
